## Business Recycling Just Got EASIER!

## **FOLLOW THESE STEPS:**

- 1. Rinse off all food residue
- 2. Pour out liquids into a sink
- 3. Flatten all materials
- 4. Stuff it all together into a designated recycling cart!

## WHAT CAN NOW BE PLACED IN ONE RECYCLING CONTAINER?

Glass (all colors)

Aluminum cans / aluminum foil

Steel / Tin cans

Clean Mixed Paper: junk mail, white or colored office paper, envelopes, newspaper, magazines and paper bags.

**Corrugated cardboard:** flatten/cut into smaller pieces; it must fit in the recycling cart.

- NO food stained (pizza boxes) or wax coated (vegetable) boxes.
- We pay by volume for collection, please flatten all materials, including cardboard. All cardboard should fit in the 96-gallon tote.
- Larger amounts of cardboard can be dropped off at the Incline transfer station, 7 days a week.
   Paperboard: food packaging (cereal boxes, soda boxes, paper towel rolls, egg cartons).
- NO used paper plates or coffee cups.

**Plastics:** All shapes and sizes with the following symbols on the bottom of the package: # 1 through #7

- No plastic bags. No plastic film. No styrofoam.
  - Note: Plastic grocery bags can be recycled at Raley's.
- o Look for these symbols on the bottom of the package for acceptable plastics:
