Common household items such as compact fluorescent light bulbs, batteries, cleaners and old electronics contain toxic chemicals which can pollute water and soil. These should NOT be disposed of in the trash. Chemicals labeled: flammable, toxic, explosive or poisonous, are especially hazardous if they are not stored properly or are left to accumulate in one place.

Get them out of your home and into our HHW center!

Limits: 5 gallons or less or total 50 lbs. at one time. Commercial accounts, we cannot service you but please contact Waste Not for referrals. We do not accept: antifreeze, car batteries or vehicle oils, but these can be recycled at the Waste Management Transfer Station, 7 days a week. Info: (775) 831-2971.

The HHW Center is normally open Tues. & Thurs. from 3-5 pm. Bring items (liquids or powders in original containers) to 1220 Sweetwater Rd, IVGID Public Works upper parking lot. Show proof of residency and it is FREE! IVGID pays the additional disposal costs.
