Director's Corner

Help save water by reporting water pipeline leaks. The Incline Village General Improvement District has over 100 miles of water pipeline to provide safe drinking water to all of our customers. These pipes are located in roadways and in easements crossing various parcels throughout Crystal Bay and Incline Village. Leaking water pipelines not only waste water but can also cost a lot to repair. The earlier a water leak is detected the faster, and cheaper, it can be repaired with less impact to you. The calls we have received from the public in the past have been very helpful in early detection. District staff also keeps a watchful eye for any water seeping out of pavement, or other odd locations, and compare it to our water pipeline locations. We also use acoustic devices that can hear the sound of running water underground caused by pipeline leaks. Please report any suspicious water percolating out of the ground to our utility office at 775-832-1203; this way we are able to respond and determine if there is a water pipeline leak so we can fix it early to save water, as well as costs.
